On 1 January 2011, the ICC's Incoterms 2010 came into force.

In the new version, compared to the ICC's Incoterms 2000, two new Incoterms codes – **DAT** (Delivered at terminal) and **DAP** (Delivered at place) – **are used instead of DAF** (Delivered at frontier), **DES** (Delivered ex-ship), **DEQ** (Delivered ex-quay), and **DDU** (Delivered duty unpaid).
